## **Bat Facts:**

There are over 1,300 different species of bats worldwide.

- 47 species of bats live in the United States.
- More than half of these bats hibernate in caves and mines to survive the winter.

(Corynorhinus townsendii virginianus)

## **VBEB Bat Facts:**

- The Virginia big-eared bat depends on caves year round. In the winter caves are used for hibernation, and in the summer they are used to raise young.
- Female bats give birth to only a single baby called a "pup."
- Young bats can generally fly within three weeks.
